 Acceptable Use Policy**

The following provisions regarding the acceptable use of computers and networks, including the Internet, shall apply to all students. All technology equipment shall be used under the supervision of the teacher and Campus Technologist.

- ___/___1. Students shall not erase, rename, or make unusable anyone else's computer files programs, or disks.
- ___/___2. Students shall not let others (other than authorized staff members) use their name, logon, password, or files for any reason.
- ___/___3. Students shall not use or try to discover another user's password.
- ___/___4. Students shall not use DISD computers or networks for any non-instructional purpose (e.g. games/activities for personal profit).
- ___/___5. Students shall not use a computer for unlawful purposes, such as the illegal copying or installation of software.
- ___/___6. Students shall not copy, change or transfer any software or documentation provided by the District, teachers or other students without permission from the campus teacher technologist.
- ___/___7. Students shall not write, produce, generate copy, propagate, or attempt to introduce any computer code designed to self-replicate, damage, or otherwise hinder the performance of any computer's memory, file system, or software. Such software is often called a virus, worm, Trojan Horse, or similar name.
- ___/___8. Students shall not deliberately use the computer to annoy or harass others with language, images, or threats. Users shall not deliberately access or create any obscene or objectionable information, language, or images.
- ___/___9. Students shall not intentionally damage the system, damage information belonging to others, misuse system resources, or allow others to misuse system resources.
- ___/___10. Students shall not tamper with computers, networks, printers, or other associated equipment except as directed by the Campus Technologist.
- ___/___11. Students are not permitted to take home technology equipment (hardware or software) without written permission of the Campus Technologist.
